PlotSpike, producers of seed and attractants for wildlife food plots, now offers professional soil testing services. Determining the pH and fertilizer requirements of the soil should be the first step in preparing any food plot. Soil test provide a starting point in determining how much lime and how much fertilizer are needed to optimize food plot production.

Soil sample collection should be made from three or four locations in any plot field and combined for a single test sample. Only a small amount of soil is needed for the test. Soil samples should be taken from the top three inches of the soil. In large fields, more than one test sample may be appropriate.

Test results from PlotSpike will include crop specific fertilizer and lime recommendations.
